

BUCKEYE SIRES BOTH CHAMPIONS IN FAST TRADE AT WESTERN CLUB SALE AT BEESTON

The Western Holstein Club's Monthly Show and Sale of Pedigree Holsteins attracted an entry of 114 Calved Cows and Heifers and Bulls for their August event. Judge for the day was Tim Rees of the Nantwich based Dalebank Herd who selected his Champion female from an entry from Enchanted Holsteins of Preston, Lancashire; this heifer, Holywood Buckeye Tara is a daughter of REW Buckeye and a member of the Wilsendale Triuna family. In reserve was Pepperstock RSVP Lulu from Speirs Farms Ltd of Luton with their homebred daughter of Kamps-Hollow Convcd RSVP who traces her family to an imported cow from the Flechedor Herd in Canada.

Champion Bull was Townhouse Kayak from SFR Farming Ltd of Clotton, Tarporley with their son of Buckeye bred from 8 generations of VG/EX dams from the Weeton Kay family and in Reserve was Ray Brown and Partners Durham Ross son, Bidlea Brandy, a member of the Hully Bang family.

Trade was very good throughout the day although one or two of the best females looked good buys in comparison to some of the lesser sorts which is unusual for this sale. However every female found a new buyer and only two of the nine bulls forward were not sold.

Top Price female went to the Champion animal, Holywood Buckeye Tara from Enchanted Holsteins when she sold to regular customer JT Parkin of Barnard Castle, County Durham. Mr. Parkin also took the next top seller, Dunnerdale Lou Kathie (VG86-2yr), by Jennie Lou-Marshall from Stephen Boow of Millom, Cumbria at 2600 gns.

At 2450 gns Pepperstock Baxter Beattie, a very fresh daughter of Emerald Acres-Sa Baxter from Gary Speirs sold to Rob Ward of Whitchurch for his Wayring Herd. At 2400 gns Mark Bowden of Malpas sold the Cedarwal Spirte daughter, Wigland Spirte Starlight to F H Cookson & Sons of Altrincham who also purchased Womack Matson Pansy at 2350 gns from the same home. At the same price Stephen Boow sold his Dunnerdale Pagewire Kim to L Davies & Son of Pencader, Carmarthen.

Two bulls made 2000 gns each and both were consigned by Ray Brown & Partners of Holmes Chapel; the first was Bidlea Plato, a son of Sterndale PS Lovejoy from the Papoose family that sold to S R Lewis of Eyton, Wrexham and the other was the Reserve Champion that sold to HR Johnson & Sons of Longnor, Buxton.
