

## **MANSONGREEN HOLSTEINS SELL TO 2050 GNS AT BEESTON**

The Mansongreen Herd of pedigree Holstein dairy cattle, the property of EJ Daniels & Son, Manson Green Farm, Hingham, Nr. Norwich was dispersed at Beeston Castle Auction on Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> May.

This loose housed herd was predominantly Autumn and winter calving and averaged over 10000 kg.

Top price of the day was 2150 gns with three others selling at 2050 gns and 2000 gns twice and all four were purchased by GA Bartlam of Bramshall, Uttoxeter. The top seller was the April calved third calver, Mansongreen Melody Beth 29<sup>th</sup> (GP81-2yr), a daughter of Moet Melody. Another third calver Mansongreen Shottle Cadet 6<sup>th</sup> (VG85-3yr) had calved in March sold for 2050 gns and the two second calvers Mansongreen Sydney Sunflower 23<sup>rd</sup> (GP81-2yr) by Airdield Sydney and Mansongreen Lucente Graceful 32<sup>nd</sup> sold for 2000 gns each.

Autumn calving heifers sold up to 1520 gns for a daughter of the Shottle son, Postlake Blaster, selling to Douglas Forsyth of Whithorn, South West Scotland who also took another by the homebred Shottle son, Mansongreen Tash at 1500 gns. Maiden heifers sold to 1000 gns twice for daughters of Tash and La Jeante Kingley both selling to DG Morris, Wrexham and calves at foot sold to 700 gns for a daughter of Bolivia Allen selling to Caldhome Farms, Crumlin, Northern Ireland.

The farms three year old Simmental stock bull, Fircovert Wilkie sold for 2150 gns to J & H Mosford of Cholmondely, Malpas.
