This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet

Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.
