It is with deep regret and much sadness that we announce the sudden and unexpected loss of Brian Pennington on 2nd November 2011.

Brian of Wistaston much loved husband of Betty and the late Margaret and a very special father, grandfather and great grandfather,

BRIAN PENNINGTON

Brian lived and worked in Cheshire all his life, his home town was Crewe where he grew up a stones throw from Gresty Road and Crewe's livestock market. His first involvement in the market was in the 1930's during school holidays when he volunteered as a boy drover for Henry Manley and Sons Limited.

On leaving school he joined the staff of Manleys before going into the Royal Navy in 1944 for two and a half years. He returned to Cheshire after the war and was soon taken on by Joseph Wright at the Whitchurch Office before permanently moving onto the livestock side of the business.

Brian was invited by Harold and Alan Wright as a partner before Joseph and Leonard Wright joined forces to become Wright and Partners and in 1979 following a further merger Wright Manley.

Brian was largely responsible for setting up a store pig section but was acclaimed for building up the cull cow section to become the largest in the country. He also started the implement and machinery sale and horse and pony sale with a particular interest in Shire Horses where he assisted in the formation of the North West and Wales Shire Foal Society.

Brian retired from the partnership in 1991 but continued to have a keen interest in the firm and up until his untimely death, was a regular visitor to Beeston most Fridays.

Acknowledged as one of the finest auctioneers of livestock in the country and will be sorely missed by all at Wright Manley and by clients throughout Cheshire, Shropshire and North Wales.

There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

CONDEMNED & REJECTED CATTLE AT THE SLAUGHTER HOUSE

Please note at Beeston we check to ensure that the Passport matches every animal by reading the clearest ear tag. It is the **owner's** responsibility to ensure that the ear tags have the same number in each ear corresponding with the passport we cannot be expected to check over 900 tags before all the animals are sold. We have had 4 cattle entered for sale over the past month with different ear tags in each ear. If this happens the animal is condemned at the abattoir no payment is made and you will get an inspection from Trading Standards. This also includes tags that have been tampered with or homemade ones!

It is the Warranties under the Food & Safety Act 1990. *The abattoir or the buyers do not want to condemn cattle it is wasting their time and money. It is in the hands of Government officials to make this decision, and if these animals are seen to be entering the food chain this may cause a public health scare?*

41 An INCREDIBLE TRADE was achieved for the type and quality forward. Trade is really as good as anywhere! Live weight cattle at the moment are dearer than the deadweight, if you have some to market why not take the test, especially with the Christmas trade upon us at the moment. Are you gaining the best price on the dead weight system it may be a little easier but you could be loosing out? **More** cattle are required each week to fulfil buyers needs. If you sell an animal in the auction and it is kept to be fed on then the buyer presents it to an abattoir within 90days, if they were purchased as Farm Assured and they turn out not to be, they will get deducted between 30–50pence per kilo dead weight.

Please clearly put on the entry card your farm assurance sticker and also in the passport marked with an “ X ” next to your off movement (as shown Below)

BROWN SWISS MEETING SPARKLING TRADE IN SECOND AUTUMN COLOURS SALE AT BEESTON

3750 GNS TOPS FARRICK DISPERSAL 5000 GNS FOR MAIDEN FROM SOMERSET

The Second part of the Autumn Colours Sale of Coloured Breed Dairy Cattle took place at Beeston on Friday, 11th November featuring entries mainly from the Brown Swiss Breed which included the dispersal sale of the FARRICK Herd, the property of Farrick Farms based Near Chipping, Preston but also a few Ayrshires as well. Unfortunately the consignment of Jerseys from Whiteoaks Farming of Swadlincote, Derbyshire were unable to be present at the Sale.

Demand for Brown Swiss seems to be on the rise and a great crowd of Breeders and Commercial milk producers from all over the UK were present.

The sale was dominated by the sale of the Farrick Herd which are kept on a very wet, exposed farm on the edge of the Trough of Bowland. Their top price was 3750 gns for the superbly bred Farrick Top Brock Viva ET a milking heifer of pure American breeding sired by Top Acres GM Brock and bred from nine generations of dams classified either VG or EX. She calved in August, had recently been bred to Payssli ET and was sold giving 24 kg. She sold to PD Hardy of Grange Mill, Nr. Matlock, Derbyshire.

Not far behind at 3300 gns was another pure American bred milking heifer; Farrick Denver Tammy (VG86-3yr) is sired by Rolling View Denver and bred from seven generations of cows scored in the top two grades. She calved in June and was sold giving 20 kg and had been bred to Payssli at the end of August. She sold to Brown Swiss Genetics of Leagram in Bowland, Lancashire. The next top seller from Farrick was the fourth calf show cow Farrick Dino 2nd ASR (Ex92) who sold for 2200 gns to Rob Darlington of Norbury, Whitchurch. She is a daughter of Red Kite Sam and was giving 36 kg. daily. She is back in-calf to Jongleur for next May.

There was also a lovely collection of heifers consigned for the Kaleidoscope section of the sale for top quality well bred individuals. The top seller here and the top price of the sale was for Sedgemoor Parker Snickerdoodle ET, an 11 month old daughter of Brothers Three Parker ET and a great grand daughter of Old Mill E Snickerdoodle (Ex94-3E) (Ex97-MS) who is probably the most famous Brown Swiss cow in Breed history. The first member of this family to sell in the UK attracted huge interest with the hammer eventually falling to David Burden for his growing herd based at Loppington, Shropshire. Mr. Burden also purchased Inspired Agenda Vogue ET, an August 2010 daughter Blessing Banker Agenda bred from the renowned Victoria family; she was consigned by Brown Swiss Genetics and sold for 3100 gns.

Another entry from Brown Swiss Genetics sold for 2400 gns; Cimarron Vigor Pauline out of an Ex92 100 tonne dam and in-calf for February sold to Roger Morse of Carmarthen who also purchased the yearling heifer Cancourt Sophie 2nd from Mike Hussey of Swindon for 2100 gns.

There were only two Brown Swiss Bulls catalogued but both sold very well; the top seller was Inspired Agenda Viagra ET, an August 2010 full brother to the 3100 gns heifer sold earlier, which sold for 2700 gns to L Poulter & Son of Evesham, Worcs whilst the other was the Rolling Court Denver son, Cancourt Saxon from Mike Hussey which sold to Richard Tomlinson of Rossett, Wrexham for 2450 gns. Ayrshire calved heifers sold to 1900 gns for an entry from Alan Coutts & Sons of Knutsford to T I M Hughes of Oswestry. Ayrshire Maiden heifers sold to 950 gns for an entry from Phil Jeffries of Berriew, Welshpool with another from Ian Patrick Of Tyldesley, Manchester selling at 900 gns both to LP Atkin of Whitgreave, Stafford.
