SINGLE FARM PAYMENT

The 2010 Forms are starting to arrive in the post. If you want some assistance contact Graham Martyn or Andrew Wallace at Beeston on 01829 262 132.

The DEADLINE for submitting them without penalty is 17th May.

There are a few changes from last year.

The 2010 payment will be based on 25% of the Entitlement held on historic subsidy receipts and a 75% Flat Rate Element.

The Euro/Sterling Exchange Rate will be taken at the end of September 2010.

In 2010 the total modulation will be 19% although the first 5000 Euro's will be exempt from EU Modulation.

ARE YOUR CATTLE RECORDS UP TO DATE?

Dairy and Beef Farmers need to check their Cattle Identification Records to ensure they comply with the rules and are up to date as it is part of the Single Farm Payment Cross Compliance.

An inspection could be called at any time to check Cattle Identification and/or Movements.

Last year approximately 50% of Livestock Farms failed!!

Failures were for not notifying births, deaths and movements, animal holding breaches, animal identification failures and passport anomalies.

Not sending a passport back to B.C.M.S. when an animal has died could cost a Farm 3% of its Single Farm Payment.

Cattle Records MUST BE KEPT FOR A MINIMUM of 10 YEARS.

If you want to check up yourself ask B.C.M.S. for a quarterly Statement.

There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old. Please check your passports are correct.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days.

Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.
