TRADE was good YET AGAIN with best Continentals to £378 for a super Blue Bull from Philip and John Riley, Minshull Vernon, while Native crossbreeds peaked at £262 for Angus Bulls and Friesian Bulls sold to £168. Fifteen Weanlings sold to £460 for five month old Blonde x Steer.

Orange Cards must be completed by all Vendors  
**EACH WEEK.**

Calves that have been Pre-Movement tested need a copy of the Vets Certificate with each passport please.

Any calves found to have the **WRONG SEX** on the Passport will be sent home for the Vendor to amend with B.C.M.S.

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old. Please check your passports are correct.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.
