The overall average dropped under £140 for the first time for several weeks but when Abattoirs are slashing prices who can blame calf buyers adjusting accordingly. Nevertheless TOP PRICE OF THE DAY was £348 for a super 39 day old Blonde x Bull from Paul Dodd, Malpas. Breed averages down on the whole partly due to demand and partly quality on offer. Sixteen calves sold in excess of £300. Only four consignments of ten or more calves. Seventy calves sold from three or four year TB status farms.

There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old. Please check your passports are correct.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

CHESTER OFFICE STRAW SALE REPORT

The Annual Wirral Straw Sale held on Monday 12th July by Chester Auctioneers Wright Manley, on behalf of E. A. Reed & Sons Limited, saw a record entry of 866 acres reach record prices, with a top price of £104 an acre being achieved for a fine stand of Winter Barley. A large crowd of regular and new purchasers, representing farmers and contractors, witnessed a total clear out of the 44 lots offered. Winter Barley was particularly keenly sought, topping at £104 an acre to average £93.20 an acre. A good show of Winter Oats reached £74 an acre, average £67.50 an acre, whilst almost 600 acres of Wheat saw a variable trade topping at £97 an acre and averaging £66 an acre.

Auctioneer Peter Lewis commented that the results are a combination of the shortage of fodder, due to the current dry spell and late Spring, no carry over stocks from the hard Winter and the transport costs and availability of Straw from the eastern counties.

NVZ RULES – In Field Muck Heaps

Farmers need to be careful they do not breach NVZ Rules when storing Muck in Fields with Land Drains. In January 2012 NVZ Rules will outlaw Muck Heaps stored within 10 metres of Land Drains and codes of Agricultural Practice already include this.

The rules require Farmers to store solid manure on an impermeable concrete platform collecting any run off which must be treated as slurry, or within an appropriately located “field heap”

This must not be within 10 metres of a land drain or within 50 metres of a Borehole.

Farmers in NVZ area are required to complete Risk Assessment Maps for spreading manure on fields and this should include which ones are land drained and the exact areas for field heaps.

You should not store manure on land likely to water log or flood, or have a heap in a single position for more than 12 months.
