ORANGE CARDS MUST BE COMPLETED BY ALL VENDORS EACH WEEK INCLUDING NAMED SIRES FOR ANGUS & HEREFORD CALVES

There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old. Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

3000 GNS TWICE FOR MONCKHAVEN YOUNG STOCK AT BEESTON

The second and final sale to disperse the Monckhaven Herd, the property of Martin and Jackie Monckton comprising the served and maiden heifer sections of the herd, took place at Beeston Castle Auction on Thursday, 12th May. The Vasami's also purchased the next top seller at 2900 gns; Monckhaven Storm Liberty 2nd ET is by September Storm and bred from five generations of Excellent dams. She is due to calve in early July to Modesto. One of the youngest calves in the sale was next in the price register; the eight month old Monckhaven Shottle Mercy 3rd ET bred from six generations of Excellent dams sold in joint deal to the Cheshire based Clayden and Wardle Herds. 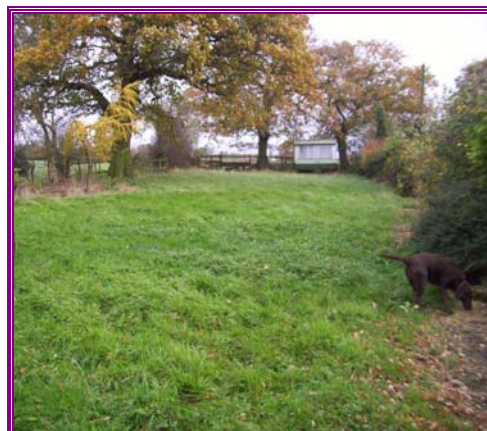
