The overall average stayed the same this week amazingly but onlookers thought the worst as plenty of really poor cows were put forward for sale. These ranged from 62p – 78p for the plain sorts. Not many steaking cows but they seemed to have no change in price at 105p – 118p. The better end of the cows saw prices reached 135p. Some didn't seem as dear as previous weeks, but many had a lot of belly which is what buyers don't want as it is just costly waste for the abattoir.

Trade looks to continue till Christmas. Please remember that the trade around this time can be hit and miss with the various abattoirs taking holidays, along with vets etc. So if you have some to sell market them well before the Christmas period only 2 more Fridays to go!

Remember if traders or direct buyers are taking them from your farm are you getting the right price? We have at least 14 buyers with 20 accounts to buy cattle not just one that gives you their price. Please contact our office with your entries so that we can sell them at a premium rather than having more than the buyers can cope with.

CONDEMNED & REJECTED CATTLE AT THE SLAUGHTER HOUSE

Please note at Beeston we check to ensure that the Passport matches every animal by reading the clearest ear tag. It is the **owner's** responsibility to ensure that the ear tags have the same number in each ear corresponding with the passport we cannot be expected to check over 900 tags before all the animals are sold. We have had 4 cattle entered for sale over the past month with different ear tags in each ear. If this happens the animal is condemned at the abattoir no payment is made and you will get an inspection from Trading Standards. This also includes tags that have been tampered with or homemade ones!

It is the Warranties under the Food & Safety Act 1990.

The abattoir or the buyers do not want to condemn cattle it is wasting their time and money. It is in the hands of Government officials to make this decision, and if these animals are seen to be entering the food chain this may cause a public health scare?

FARM ASSURANCE

Vendors please ensure that the cattle you sell are correctly **FARM ASSURED.**

If you sell an animal in the auction and it is kept to be fed on then the buyer presents it to an abattoir within 90days, if they were purchased as Farm Assured and they turn out not to be, they will get deducted between 30–50pence per kilo dead weight. Please clearly put on the entry card your farm assurance sticker and also in the passport marked with an " X " next to your off movement (as shown Below)
