This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Orange Cards must be completed by all Vendors **EACH WEEK**.

Calves that have been Pre-Movement tested need a copy of the Vets Certificate with each passport please.

Any calves found to have the **WRONG SEX** on the Passport will be sent home for the Vendor to amend with B.C.M.S.

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at

least ten days old. Please check your passports are correct.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days.

Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

## ***VIOLIN BOW SCORES TOP PRICE OF £7,000 AT RECENT FINE ART AUCTION***

The Fine art auction and antiques at Wright Manley's Beeston Castle salerooms is always well attended. **PAINTINGS** watercolours by John Trivett Nettlehip of a lion taking fish and a black bear brought £480 and £260, a painting by Tom Lloyd "Herding the Sheep with children a sheepdog and ducks" brought £400, a pair of delightful pictures by K.C. Brown of Pomeranian dogs from Ivy Bank Farm brought £420, Albert Clark "Study of a shire horse in a country landscape" brought £1,250, a country scene depicting a mill with figures unloading a horse drawn cart £700, a Nantwich artist Herbert H Jones, Study of a racehorse, "Rainbow" was competed for by a collector from America and bought for £600.
