There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

### **3300 GNS TOP BID AT NEW FRIDAY CLUB SALE AT BEESTON – SEVEN OVER 2500 GNS**

For the first time since the Western Holstein Club Shows and Sales moved to Beeston Castle Auction over eleven years ago they have now changed their selling day to a Friday. It is viewed by all concerned as a very positive move as it now takes place on the same day as the weekly commercial market where there are sections for cull cows, calves store and fat cattle and gets over the problem of not conflicting with the six day movement rule enabling farmers to sell their calves and culls and buy their replacements on the same day. If the results of the first Friday event are anything to go by, the sales will definitely have a bright future as there were certainly many more buyers about and everyone went home more than satisfied.

The judge for this sale was Rob Ward who runs the Waying Herd at Whitchurch and for his Champion he selected the fresh third calf cow, Sandley Jazz 43rd (EX90) from the Porter family of Monneley Farm Partners of Barthomley, Crewe who consigned a large number to the sale as part of a major herd reduction to celebrate twenty years of breeding holsteins. They also were awarded the Reserve Championship with their heifer Monlea Shottle Celestial (VG86-2yr) who was also a member of the first prize pair. Buyers were out in force and were in attendance from Southern Scotland to West Wales as well as a large representation from the locality and its surrounding counties. The overall trade was very good, although trade for the cows early on in the sale appeared to be a little sticky, but it soon gathered pace and heifer trade was beyond expectations.

The top price of the day was 3300 gns for the reserve Champion, a milking heifer that calved last October and was due again in September to Crackholm Fever. She is a daughter of Shottle and is the 6<sup>th</sup> generation of animals classified in the top two grades. She was purchased by Dyfrig Davies of Pencader, Carmarthen for his Llanllwni Herd. He also purchased the Champion, a third generation EX/VG fresh third calf cow also by Shottle for 2800 gns. The Porter's had two other heifers selling at 2800 gns each; the first was Monbar Final Cut Bang (VG86-2yr), a daughter of Gillette Final Cut that calved last October and was due again with her second in September to Crackholm Fever. She was purchased by Distinctive Holsteins of Dutton, Warrington whilst the other at this price was Monlea Bambam Celestial (VG85-2yr) a fresh calved daughter of Braedale Bambam who is the sixth generation of cows classified in the top two grades and purchased by Thomas Plas Ltd of Carmarthen.

Two fresh heifers sold for 2550 gns each; the first, from Rob Barnett of Whitchurch, was Hully Degas Jenny 7th by BMW Degas with two Excellent dams and the second was Ketteringham Homestead Magpie by Bomaz Homestead Magpie consigned by Jack and Barclay Taylor of Shrewsbury. Both these heifers were purchased by the same undisclosed Scottish purchaser. The only other animal to sell for 2500 gns was Tristar Minister Margot, a recently (VG85-2yr) sired by Mr. Minister and who is now 7th generation heifer scored in the top two grades. She was purchased by A & V Wallbank of Longridge, Preston. A further 15 heifers made from 2250 to 2450 gns. Apart from the Monbar/Monlea consignment other cows topped at 2000 gns for Budworth Cutler Gloria from Ivan Shepherd for a second calf daughter of Gillette Cutler whilst the group of maiden heifers from the Porters sold to 1500 gns for Monbar Mr. Burns Betsy an August 2010 daughter of Dudoc Mr. Burns selling to Aintree Holsteins.

### **BROWN SWISS DOMINATE ORGANIC CROSSBRED SALE AT WREXHAM**

The Environment Agency are carrying out inspections of Farms to check you are complying with Environmental Regulations.

Here is a list of what they require to see on an inspection:-

- A Map of the farmed area showing Watercourses, Springs and Wells.
- Your Fertiliser Plan and detailed records of Manure/Fertiliser applied to fields for the year 2010/11 (including crops and yield, field areas, application rates and dates).
- Your Organic manure spreading risk map.
- N Max Calculations.
- Organic Manure import or export records (to include precise information on quantities, dates of movements, origin and recipient of the manure).
- Livestock number records.
- Location of Fertiliser and manure storage areas.
- Location, and accurate storage capacity details, of any slurry lagoons, fuel tanks and silage clamps.
- An accurate drainage plan showing location of clean and dirty drains and size of yard area (in m<sup>2</sup>) draining to the slurry and dirty water systems.
- Records of waste and hazardous waste storage locations and movements.
- Your water abstraction licence and records of water abstracted
