BRIAN PENNINGTON

Brian lived and worked in Cheshire all his life, his home town was Crewe where he grew up a stones throw from Gresty Road and Crewe's livestock market. His first involvement in the market was in the 1930's during school holidays when he volunteered as a boy drover for Henry Manley and Sons Limited.

On leaving school he joined the staff of Manleys before going into the Royal Navy in 1944 for two and a half years. He returned to Cheshire after the war and was soon taken on by Joseph Wright at the Whitchurch Office before permanently moving onto the livestock side of the business.

Brian was invited by Harold and Alan Wright as a partner before Joseph and Leonard Wright joined forces to become Wright and Partners and in 1979 following a further merger Wright Manley.

Brian was largely responsible for setting up a store pig section but was acclaimed for building up the cull cow section to become the largest in the country. He also started the implement and machinery sale and horse and pony sale with a particular interest in Shire Horses where he assisted in the formation of the North West and Wales Shire Foal Society.

Brian retired from the partnership in 1991 but continued to have a keen interest in the firm and up until his untimely death, was a regular visitor to Beeston most Fridays.

Acknowledged as one of the finest auctioneers of livestock in the country and will be sorely missed by all at Wright Manley and by clients throughout Cheshire, Shropshire and North Wales.

INCLUDING NAMED SIRES FOR ANGUS &
HEREFORD CALVES**

There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

CONDEMNED & REJECTED CATTLE AT THE SLAUGHTER HOUSE

Please note at Beeston we check to ensure that the Passport matches every animal by reading the clearest ear tag. It is the **owner's** responsibility to ensure that the ear tags have the same number in each ear corresponding with the passport we cannot be expected to check over 900 tags before all the animals are sold. We have had 4 cattle entered for sale over the past month with different ear tags in each ear. If this happens the animal is condemned at the abattoir no payment is made and you will get an inspection from Trading Standards. This also includes tags that have been tampered with or homemade ones!

It is the Warranties under the Food & Safety Act 1990.

The abattoir or the buyers do not want to condemn cattle it is wasting their time and money. It is in the hands of Government officials to make this decision, and if these animals are seen to be entering the food chain this may cause a public health scare?

FARM ASSURANCE

Vendors please ensure that the cattle you sell are correctly **FARM ASSURED**.

If you sell an animal in the auction and it is kept to be fed on then the buyer presents it to an abattoir within 90days, if they were purchased as Farm Assured and they turn out not to be, they will get deducted between 30–50pence per kilo dead weight.

Please clearly put on the entry card your farm assurance sticker and also in the passport marked with an “ X ” next to your off movement (as shown Below)

BEST EVER WEXHAM CUP BULL SALE AT BEESTON TOP OF 7500 GNS AND A RECORD AVERAGE

The 60th Annual Wexham Cup Show and Sale of Holstein Bulls for members of the Western Holstein Club attracted an entry of 69 superbly bred animals for this year’s event at Beeston Castle Auction Cheshire of which 62 were forward on the day.

The judge this year was that well known breeder Peter Waring of the noted Winton Herd based at Beverley, East Yorkshire. The Champion bull on Inspection was Woodmarsh Salvo, a son of Sicy Knowledge from M & JC Gould Ltd of Bomere Heath, Shrewsbury and the Reserve was Bidlea Appleton, a son of Riverdane Roses Reflection from Ray Brown & Partners of Holmes Chapel.

The Wexham Cup, where the bulls compete on their individual inspection for which points are awarded and these are then added to points gained for pedigree, index and dam’s production was won this year by Holmland Varon ET, a son of Long-Langs Oman Oman exhibited by Steve Bell of Penrith and Paul Findley of Wrexham. In reserve was Wintersell Million Miles by England-Ammon Million from John Downing of Edenbridge, Kent.

A huge crowd assembled in the sale ring ready for the sale, probably as large a crowd as had been seen for many years. Trade started out a little steady to begin with but soon gathered momentum with bidding at times being fast and furious as buyers competed to acquire the best genetics on offer. The overall result at the end of the day rewarded vendors with a record average in excess of £2500 with 13 bulls selling for 3000 gns or more and many intending purchasers going home empty handed.

Wrexham also had a good day claiming two of the leading bids of the sale; their top seller which was the third highest price of the day, was Aintree Notch, a son of Schillview Oman Gerard born last November and bred from 4 generations of VG/Ex dams from their renowned Nugget family. He sold for 4500 gns to WP & JP Davies of Abergele, Denbighshire. They also sold Aintree Ninja, a son of Macomber O-Man Bogart also from the Nugget family for 4000 gns to R H Lewis & Son of Crickheath, Oswestry. John Downing made the long journey from Edenbridge, Kent and was rewarded with two of the top prices; his Reserve for the Wexham Cup, Wintersell Million Miles bred from the outstanding Mila family sold for 4400 gns to WR Wilson of Ellonby, Penrith. Another from the same stable Wintersell Mandrake by Million and bred from eight successive generations of VG/Ex dams from the Amanda/August line; he sold for 4000 gns to John and Ruth Edge of Wimboldsley Holsteins, Middlewich. Matt Fisher of Eamont Bridge, Penrith entered just the one bull for the sale and achieved one of the top prices selling his Newtonmoss Edward, by Shottle from the Elegance family for 3800 gns to RE & J Roberts of Whitford, Holywell, Flintshire. At just 100 gns less was another from the Goulds; Woodmarsh Platinum, by Atlas from the Pledge family sold for 3700 gns to L Hadfield & Sons of Buxton, Derbyshire.

The Wexham Cup winner from Bell and Findley, Holmland Varon, also from the Pledge family sold for 3200 gns to F Jackson & Son of Oswestry whilst another from the same home, Holmland Emilio, by Bolivia Allen from the Oralie line sold for 3600 gns to TG & DM Watchorn of Melton Mowbray, Leicestershire.

It is now ten years since Wright Manley started selling pedigree Suffolk in-lamb females at Beeston Castle Auction. Cheshire and in that period the sale has gone from strength to strength; it is certainly correct to state that the Sale is now the top sale of it's kind for the breed in the country.

The sale this year attracted a wonderful entry of 186 in-lamb ewes and gimmers and ewe lambs representing many of the Britain's best flocks and it has to be said the quality was amazing. We've certainly come along way since the first sale!

She is a daughter of their 8000 gns stock tup Stockton Joint Venture and after a three way battle between a Lancashire breeder, a Dutch breeder bidding on the phone, the hammer was eventually knocked down to Mary-Julia Cornish for her Mardle Flock based at Buckfastleigh, Devon.

Two sheep made 3000 gns a piece; the first to hit this price was the 2nd prize winner in the in-lamb gimmer class from Kevin Proctor of the Conveth Flock based at Turriff Aberdeenshire. This was a daughter of the 20000 gns National Sale Champion 2009 and 'Sire of the Year' 2010, Cairness Achievement; she sold to join the Rookery Flock of Chris Holmes at Broadway, Worcestershire. Also at this price was the Show Champion; the ewe lamb from David Jones' Drwsnant Flock. This outstanding sheep is by Baileys Brigadier

The Second and sold in a two way split to the father and son team, Hugh and Harry Annett for their Widdrington Flock at Morpeth, Northumberland and John Campbell of the Thrunton Flock at Alnwick, Northumberland.

Three others broke through the 2000 gns mark; the highest priced of these was a February born ewe lamb by Strathisla Ace from the Keighley based Jubilee Flock of Mark Evans. She sold for 2200 gns to join the Safaddan Flock of Mike

Davies & Sons at Brecon. Jimmy Douglas of the Aberdeenshire based Cairness Flock has been a regular supporter of the sale for many years and again was rewarded with some top prices. His top seller was a three crop ewe by Thurston Chieftain in lamb to the 10000 euro Ardlea Arkle; this lovely ewe out of a Glensisla dam sold for 2050 gns and makes the long journey back north selling to G Troup of the Whitestone Flock at Sauchen, Aberdeenshire. At 2000 gns Ross Fotheringham of the Oldmill Flock at Fraserburgh, Aberdeenshire purchased a two crop ewe also by Thurston Chieftain and in-lamb to Arkle from the Cairness consignment.

The reserve overall Champion from Jack Pryce was the next in the price stakes selling his gimmer to Martin Howard of Press Green, Shropshire for 1500 gns and at the same price David Jones of Drwsnant sold the mother of the 3000 Championship winning lamb, a two crop ewe by the 7000 gns Landale Leader Lad to H Annett & Son.
