### **ORANGE CARDS MUST BE COMPLETED BY ALL VENDORS EACH WEEK INCLUDING NAMED SIRES FOR ANGUS & HEREFORD CALVES**

There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old. Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days. Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

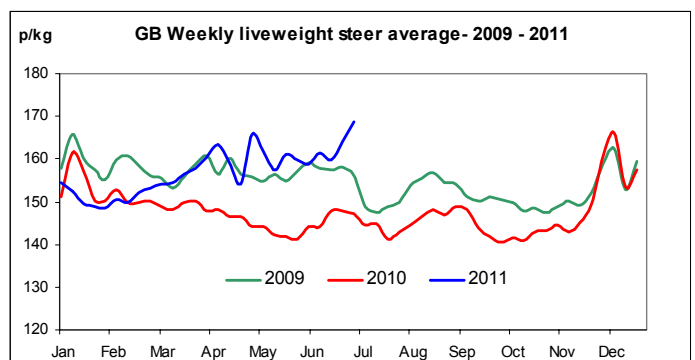

### INTERESTING FACTS

The Netherlands remained the leading destination for UK beef exports in 2011 and accounted for nearly half of total UK exports. Ireland was the second largest destination for UK exports accounting for a further 21% of the export market. Shipments to France grew by a third in the period and accounted for 10% of the market.

Roasting joint purchases fell by 6% compared with the corresponding period a year earlier. Frying and grilling steak purchases in the period dropped by 10% compared with year earlier volumes. Stewing and minced beef recorded higher volume purchases on the year, increasing by 1% and 3% respectively. Volume purchases of beef burgers and grills were 7% higher on the year.

The liveweight prime cattle trade has remained firm at GB auction markets in recent months. Steer prices peaked during the holiday period in late April, at 166p per kg, before easing back to 158p per kg in mid-May. However, by late June the trade firmed to average 169p per kg, which was 21 pence or 15% higher compared with a year earlier.
