Continental Bulls largely similar to last week, medium and better Continental Heifers less money, Hereford Bulls dearer, Angus Bulls down in value, while better Friesian Bulls were a real, REAL TRADE.

104 Bulls to £358 for G. Green & Sons Belgian Blue to average £269.74 very similar to last week. Simmentals had the best average at £282.58 up £10 with a super run of nine four week olds from C. & S. Fitton & Son averaging £323 per head. Blues averaged a fiver less, but the best were still £300 plus. A mixed bag of seventeen Limousins saw a high of £348 but only four topped £270. Four more mediums made £230 to £240 and six more £150 to £198. More Charolais and a good average with a high of £346 for T. Lunt & Son.

103 Heifers peaked at £290 for Walker & Hargreaves Belgian Blue to average £19 less overall with some “good value”. Charolais had the top average at £221.20. Blues averaged £12 less at £217.88. Simmentals averaged £21 less at £209.96 with some good shapey sorts £220 to £240. Not many Heifers under £150. It may be the “Time to Buy”?

This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Orange Cards must be completed by all Vendors
EACH WEEK.

Calves that have been Pre-Movement tested need a copy of the Vets Certificate with each passport please.

Any calves found to have the **WRONG SEX** on the Passport will be sent home for the Vendor to amend with B.C.M.S.

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old. Please check your passports are correct.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days.

Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.
