There is a **NEW FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION FORM** which needs **COMPLETING** and **SIGNING** with each batch of calves that could go for **PROCESSING**. This is a Declaration about whether any calf has been injected if so with what **DRUG** and when the withdrawal period finishes. Copies are available from the Market Office. This is particularly relevant to Holstein, Ayrshire, Jersey, Brown Swiss and Swedish Red Bulls, Holstein Free Martin Heifers and very small crossbreds

Calves between seven and nine days old are subject to transport restrictions. Only buyers from within forty miles can buy them. Ideally sell your calves at least ten days old.

Remember calves over 42 days from one or two year T.B. Status Farms will need a T.B. Test and then sold with a Vet Certificate which is valid for sixty days.

Ideally sell your calves under 40 days old.

AMAZING ACTONFARM DISPERSAL! HUGE CROWD AND INCREDIBLE TRADE! COWS TO 9000 GNS! CALVES TO 3500 GNS!

The Dispersal of virtually the entire ACTON Herd of Ayrshires and the ACTONFARM Herd of Holsteins took place at Beeston Castle Auction on Friday, 9th September on behalf of John Tomlinson of Church Farm, Acton, Nantwich who was selling due to his current illness.

The purchaser was Philip Williams of Leweston, Haverfordwest. The contending bidder for the Saltire was Tracey Martin of Torrington, Devon who was very keen to acquire a member of the Peggy family; she did not go home disappointed as she was the successful bidder the second top seller purchasing Acton CBC Peggy (VG86-3yr), a milking heifer who calved in June sired by Carnell Bright Crown, for 7100 gns. She is out of a (VG85) Trident's Lot daughter of the old Peggy cow.

The third top seller was Acton Princess Poker (VG87) a July calved daughter of McCornick Nelson milking with her third calf and out of an (LP60)(Ex90) daughter of Bankend Lord Ontario; she was purchased for 6100 gns by Steve Oultram for his Stamford Herd at Ewloe, Flintshire her fresh calved heifer daughter ib Hidden Valley Garth for 3100 gns.
