

COMMERCIAL HOLSTEINS TO £1910 AT BEESTON

A very good crowd of mainly local buyers were in attendance at Beeston Castle Auction for the dispersal sale of the commercial herd of Holstein dairy cattle on behalf of Richard Owen of Ferny Lees Farm, Tiverton, Tarporley who is relinquishing the tenancy of the farm.

Top price was £1910 achieved for a fresh heifer selling to T E Davies & Son of Ruabon, Wrexham with another selling for £1900 to JJ & AS Nicholas of Rushton, Tarporley. Another fresh heifer made £1800 to Hill and Davies of Wrexham whilst cows also sold to this figure for a fresh third calver giving 48.4 kg selling to the Clayton Partnership of Malpas. In-calf heifers topped at £1610 for a lovely heifer not far off to the Angus selling to L Griffiths & Sons of Marchwile, Wrexham.
