

1810 GNS TOPS ROYELLE HERD SALE

A good crowd turned up at Beeston Castle Auction for the sale of the entire milking portion of the Royelle Herd of pedigree and unregistered Holsteins on behalf of Bankhead Dairy Farmers, Bank Head Farm, Broxton, Chester.

The top price was realised for a fresh, unregistered second calf daughter of Scotchhills Patriot which was sold giving 38 kg. daily to JG Williams, Nantwich. Another fresh second calf daughter of Mickerra Galileo sold at 1720 gns to Nick Bate of Great Budworth, Northwich and Messrs Hill & Davies of Wrexham also secured a second calf daughter of Rossett James for 1700 gns.

Demand was very good for the fresh calved cattle and those that are due in the early part of the new year, but those that had calved in the summer were harder to sell.
