

EXCELLENT RICKI LEADS TAMESIDE DISPERSAL AT 3200 GNS.

A good turnout of buyers were in attendance at Beeston Castle Auction for the final sale to disperse the Tameside Herd of Pedigree Holsteins, the property of brothers Ellis and Tom Summerscales and removed from their high and exposed Oak Farm, Matley, Nr. Stalybridge situated at about 1000 ft on the edge of the High Peak. The decision to retire was made about eighteen months ago and last year they reduced the milkers by some sixty head selling them as they calved and also sold forty bulling heifers. This left numbers at this final sale comprising 111 milkers and 78 served and maiden heifers and heifer calves of which a handful were not forward on the day.

The quality of the cattle was good although there were quite a proportion of older cows in the milkers and also a high proportion of cows that had calved in the winter, some of which were guaranteed back in-calf and some were not. The resultant trade was very good for all the senior stock but all ages of younger stock appeared a little harder to clear at recent levels, no doubt due to the lack of grass in many parts of the country. Nevertheless buyers gathered from many different parts and the cattle were distributed to Cumbria, North and West Yorkshire, Kent, West Wales as well as the locality and its surrounding counties.

Top price of the day was 3200 gns paid for the third calf cow Tameside Ricki 6th (Ex90) a daughter of Comestar Outside tracing to the well known show cow Calbrett Astro Ricki. This very powerful, handsome cow had calved in April and was sold giving 44.7 kg. She sold to Lin Davies to join his noted Meurig Herd based at Carmarthen West Wales. He also purchased Tameside Jonquil 78th (VG87)(Ex-MS), a fresh third calf daughter of Talent sold giving 49 kg for 2600 gns.

The second top price was 3100 gns for the wonderful catalogue cover girl, Tameside Vaakje 4th (Ex90), a daughter of Integrity, who is the tenth generation of VG/EX cows from the noted Stardale Vaakje family, Vaakje 4th calved her fourth calf in January and was sold giving 46 kg daily to Dennis Hughes of Clayden Holsteins at Haslington, Crewe. AT 2500 gns Richard Thompson who runs the Grinkle Herd with his wife Heather, at Whitby North Yorkshire selected the Bosside Roma Roman daughter Tameside Pamela 2nd (VG88); she is the sixth generation of cows classified in the top two grades and was back in calf for early November to Buckeye.

In-calf heifers sold to 2000 gns for another member of the Vaakje family sired by Sterndale Fanatic selling to JH & R Morris of Sontley, Wrexham whilst recently served and maiden heifers sold to 1750 gns for a member of the Pamela family, also sired by Fanatic which sold to MN Probert of Shrewsbury. Heifer calves topped at 1000 gns for an August 09 daughter of Atlas also from the Vaakje family.
