

A WHOPPING 46 ANIMALS SMASHED THROUGH
THE 2000GNS BARRIER
AT THE JULY WESTERN HOLSTEIN CLUB SALES
AT BEESTON AND CHELFORD

BEESTON SALE:

A huge entry difference for this month, 142 animals catalogued for the Western Holstein Club sale, for cattle who reside outside the Blue Tongue and protection areas, also this was the first month that Vaccinated cattle free to move were made available to the open market, several consigners were in attendance from these areas.

The judge for the day was Will Glen from Distinctive Holsteins, strong classes of cattle were out in the show ring. Will made his decision on his champion animal and this was awarded to A L Moore & Partners of Byley, Middlewich, with their super heifer Danevalley Jordan Favourite 3rd, a daughter of Roylane Jordan, which calved early June she sold for 2350gns to Mr H W Evans of Llansilin, Oswestry. The Judge selected lot 119 for his Reserve Champion from J & J M Walmsley of Garstang, Preston Fordswood Samuelo Music PI a daughter of Regancrest-Mr Samuelo ET, this heifer calved on the 17th July and was secured for 2400gns by Trebersed Farm Partnership, Carmarthen.

The days trade was very pleasing with a top price of 3800gns being achieved by a super red heifer from David and Stella Rutter of Delamere who had a consignment of cows in this sale to disperse their good Delwin herd.

Delwin Cheech Teezie Red a daughter of Morrill J Cheech Red ET calved on the 21st July, and was 3rd prize heifer in the Junior Heifer class, she was keenly sought with the hammer finally falling to the lucky purchaser, Messrs D E M & A Davies of Llanarthne, Carmarthen.

The Stafford family's return to Beeston following vaccination saw lot 138 Saxelby Westminster Sallie PI bred from nine generations of cows scored in the top two grades, weighing in at 32.6kg daily; she was purchased by Mr J C Bellerby of Leeds, West Yorkshire for 2850gns.

Messrs A R & E R Jones had a super consignment of heifers forward, with a top price of 2700gns being achieved this was for Hendy Igniter Olwen, this daughter of Summersshade Igniter calved on the 13th June and was milking very well achieving a daily yield of 38.kg daily, D E M & A Davies of Llanarthne secured her for their Paxtonview herd who also purchased the very good heifer Yatehouse Jackson Renate Red for 2250 gns from Messrs EV & B Boughey & Son, Tarpurley.

A fantastic trade and turnout at Beeston saw an average of £1397.76 for Cows; £1879.61 for Heifers; Overall Average being £1793.95.

CHELFORD SALE:

The Judge for the day was Mr Richard Griffiths (Goostrey Holsteins). Richard selected Whartonspool Ruben Helene ET PI for his Champion animal this super well bred heifer from M J & M Nash is bred from 8 generations of cows scored in the top two grades and traces back to the world renown Horizon Jub Helene ET (**Ex94-2E & SP 28***) she calved on the 24th June and was giving 32.8kg daily, the hammer finally fell at 3600gns to Messrs J C Bell of Toft. Reserve Champion was taken by Ray Brown & partners with Bidlea Inter Darkie (**GP82-2yr**) (**VG-MS**). This good heifer calved on the 12th June and was snapped up for 2000gns by N & C Trickett of Chesterton, Newcastle. The trade was very consistant throughout with numbers a little thin on the ground.

The average for Cows was £1732.50; Heifers £1941.88, Overall Average being £1910.48.
